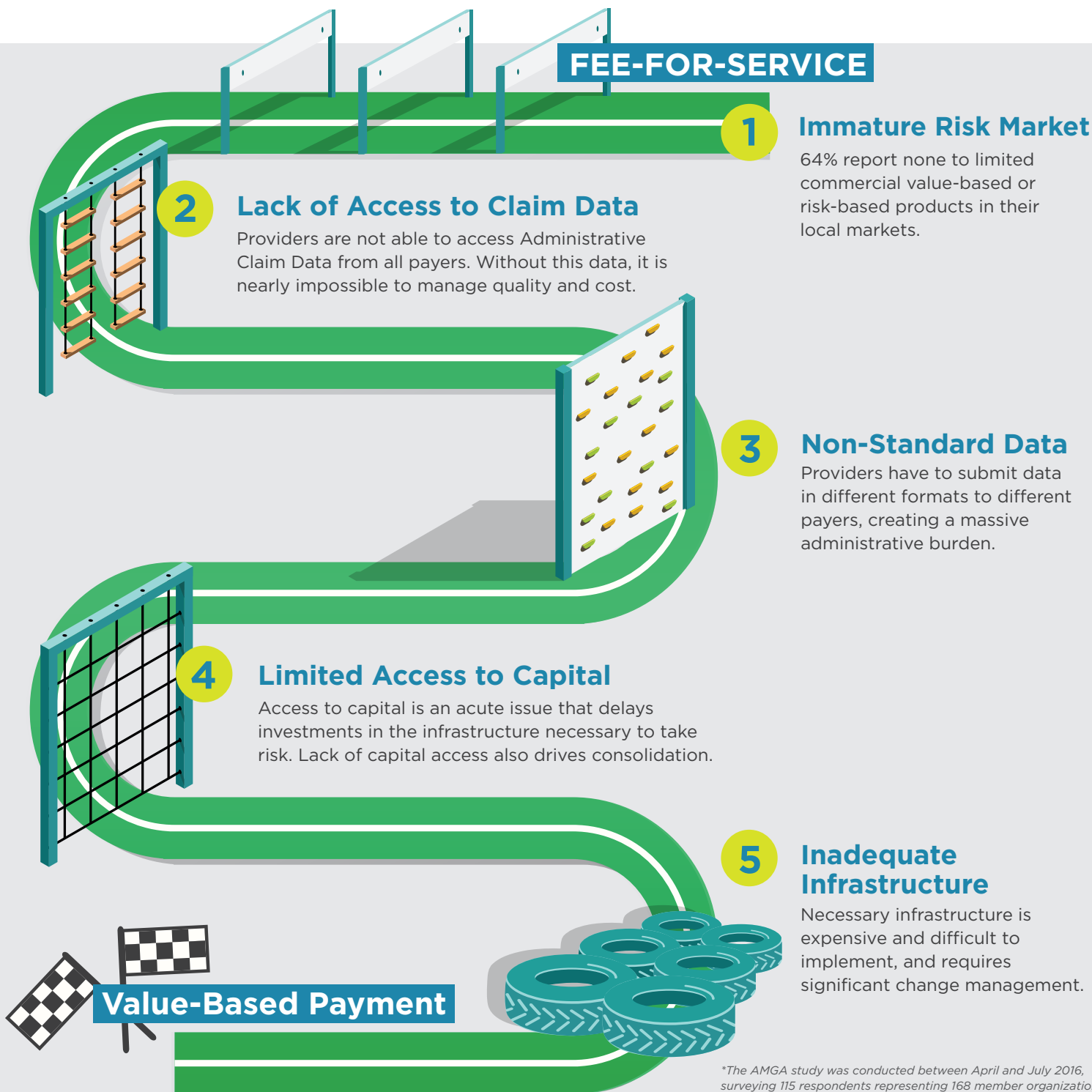


# Obstacles to Value-Based Health Care

AMGA's second annual survey on taking risk asked its membership if the transition to value-based payments is continuing and if obstacles to taking risk remain. AMGA members—multispecialty medical groups and integrated systems of care that deliver care to one in three Americans—reported that the transition away from fee-for-service medicine continues, but at a slower pace than anticipated.

**58%** of multispecialty medical groups and integrated delivery systems surveyed are ready to accept downside risk within **two years**, but five obstacles are slowing the transition from fee-for-service to value-based payments.
