Assemble an immunization team for a meeting



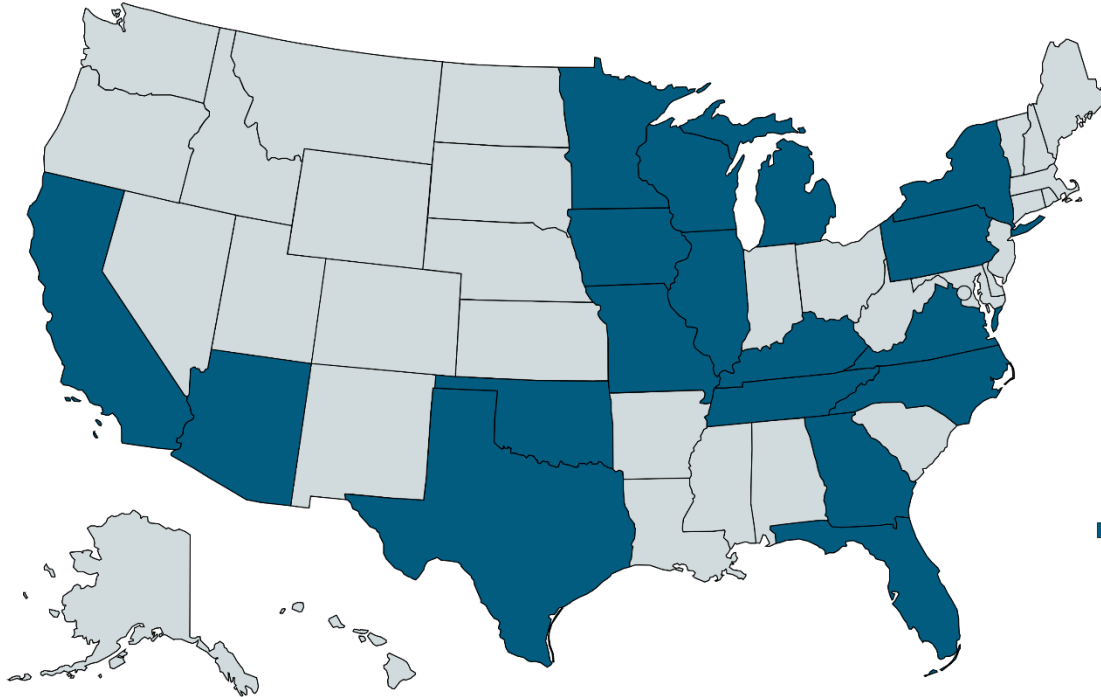
Choose two or three opportunities to support vaccination in your practice

# Spotlight: Ballad Health



During Ballad Health's RIZE Action Month meeting, the team reviewed their immunization performance and discussed utilizing messaging to close care gaps.

They also discussed working with their system pharmacy to hold vaccination rodeos in offices to catch-up patients.

Utica Park Clinic discussed continuing their drive-thru clinics for flu and pneumococcal vaccines, among other timely topics.

To prepare for flu season, they plan to review standing orders with medical assistants in the clinic.

# Spotlight: Norton Medical Group



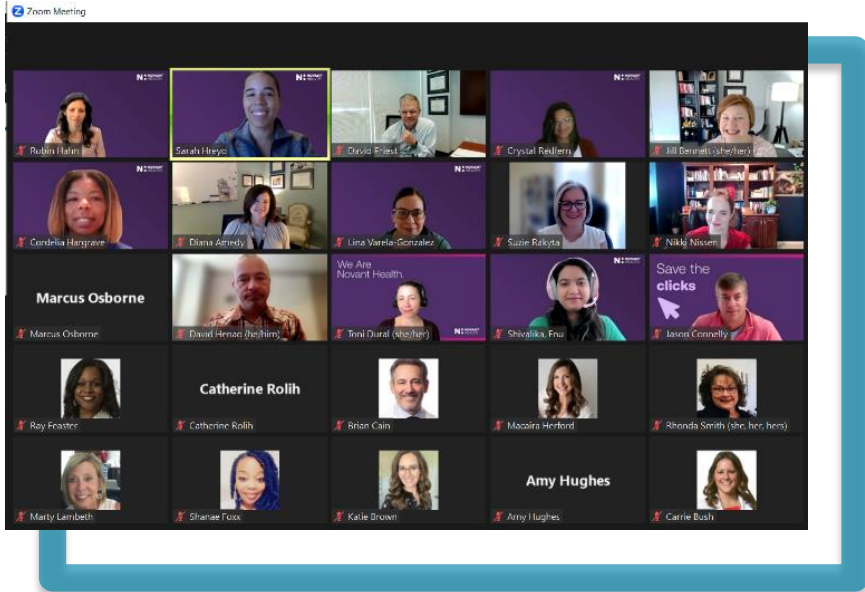
Norton Medical Group's first Spanish-English bilingual clinic participated in RIZE Action Month this year!
