


### **January 2022 Edition**

#### **Happy New Year!**

On January 17, we observed Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day (MLK Day) and reflected on the work that still needs to be done for racial equality. MLK Day is observed every year on the third Monday in January and is meant to be more than just a holiday or a day off. It is a time to reflect and take action on civil rights issues across the globe.



MLK Day was a concept initially proposed by labor unions. After his death, U.S. Representative John Conyers and U.S. Senator Edward Brooke introduced a bill in Congress to make his birthday a national holiday. There was opposition to make it a paid federal holiday because it would be too expensive and because he was a private citizen. However, The King Center garnered support from the corporate community and public, as well hosted the Rally for Peace Press Conference in 1981. Stevie Wonder's "Happy Birthday" single helped popularized the campaign even further. According to National Today, 6 million signatures were collected on a petition for Congress to pass the law, and it is considered the largest petition in favor of an issue in U.S. history. President Reagan signed a bill to create a federal holiday honoring Dr. King in 1983. The holiday honoring the civil rights leader was first observed on his actual birthday, January 20, 1986.

As we think about what the true meaning of the words *equality* and *equity* and their impact on the healthcare system, we encourage everyone to reflect on a quote from Dr. King, which is still very relevant today.

"It's all right to tell a man to lift himself by his own bootstraps, but it is cruel jest to say to a bootless man that he ought to lift himself by his own bootstraps."
