Over the first four years of the campaign, our RIZE groups have administered or documented a total of 28.2 million vaccines, bringing us closer to our goal of 30 million vaccines by 2027! Check out our updated <u>campaign infographic</u>, which shows impact by vaccine over these four years. Your hard work is helping protect more adult patients from vaccine-preventable diseases. Congratulations to all RIZE groups!

In the fourth year of the campaign alone, participating groups administered or documented **nearly 8 million vaccinations** to their patients, including:

- 4.505.936 flu vaccines
- 221,265 pneumococcal vaccines
- 886,940 Td/Tdap vaccines
- 473,008 zoster vaccines
- 52,998 RSV vaccines
- 1,628,209 COVID vaccines
- 206,438 hepatitis B vaccines

We look forward to continuing to measure progress toward the campaign goal and sharing your successes! Flu by the Numbers

The 2024-2025 flu season was classified by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) as a high severity season overall and for all age groups—the first such since 2017-2018. With an estimated 47 million illnesses, 610,000 hospitalizations, and 26,000 deaths in the U.S. alone, it has been one of the most severe in over a decade.

To keep track of these alarming trends, the CDC monitors and records U.S. flu activity weekly in a report called "FluView." The first full FluView of the 2025-2026 season will be released on Friday, Oct. 10, 2025, and select data will be featured in the November edition of *RIZE Monthly*.
