The first quarterly data report for the Rise to Immunize™ campaign is due **Feb. 15**. This first report will include two Measurement Years of baseline data (Q3 2019-Q2 2020 and Q3 2020-Q2 2021) and two quarters of intervention data (Q3 and Q4 of 2021). To complete the data report, your team will need to fill out the <u>Excel Reporting Template</u> with all requested data – according to your data track (Basic or Core) – and email the final report to <u>DataForRIZE@amga.org</u>.
